## Douglas Fir

Wood used to build a temporary entrance to the Bay Bridge's bike path was in place less than 7 months. The wood structure with metal rails stretched 3000 feet long and connected the permanent bike/pedestrian path (attached to the new bridge) to the touchdown at the eastern end of the bridge. Douglas Fir beams are now available for re-use on your next project.
