## California Redwood

Built in 1910, this seed barn in San Juan Bautista was a big part of the Ferry Morse Seed Company's success. In the mid-19th century the Ferry Morse Seed Company was the world's largest seed producer and this three-story barn was where a wide variety of fruit and flower seeds were processed. Generations of workers earned their living at the seed barn and actually lived on-site in barracks. For many families the seed barn was the center of their community and the place they called home.
