Douglas Fir

For many years, wineries used large redwood tanks to store, ferment, and age their wine. Some of these tanks reached up to 19' tall, 20' wide and held 50-60 thousand gallons of wine. Now however, many wineries are transitioning to stainless steel tanks, with economics as the main driver. Stainless steel tanks provide wine-makers with more control over flavor and enable them to accelerate the aging process. As a result, beautiful old growth Douglas fir underpinnings used to support the wine tanks are available for new projects.
